These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the Village of Perry.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about September 12, 2022, the Village of Perry will submit a request to the Office of Community Renewal for the release of CDBG funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake a project known as 'Perry Storm Drainage Improvements' for the purpose constructing approx. 4,135 LF of 12-in smooth interior corrugated polyethylene pipe (SCIPP) storm sewer mains and 106 LF of 6-in storm sewer lateral pipes to replace the existing undersized and deteriorated storm sewers along Olin Ave from Main St to the end of the Village owned portion of the Road, Benedict St from Olin Ave to Main St, Watkins Ave from Benedict St to N. Center St and Hawthorne St from Watkins Ave to Leicester St. The project also includes the replacement of 39 catch basins and restoration of streets, sidewalks, and driveways (as needed) throughout the project area. The total project cost is estimated to be \$707,500, including \$672,500 in CDBG funding and \$35,000 in local (Village) funding.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Village of Perry has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at the Village of Perry, 46 North Main Street, Perry, New York and may be examined or copied weekdays 9 AM to 5 PM.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Village of Perry certifies to the Office of Community Renewal that Frederic Hauser, in his capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The Office of Community Renewal's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Village of Perry to use Program funds.

OBJECTION TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Office of Community Renewal will accept objections to its release of funds and the Village of Perry's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (1) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Village of Perry; (b) the Village of Perry has omitted a step or filed to make a decision of finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the Office of Community Renewal; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory form the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted via email in accordance with the required procedures at 24 CFR Part 58, Section 58.76 and shall be addressed to the NYS Office of Community Renewal at ben.mattison@nyshcr.org.
