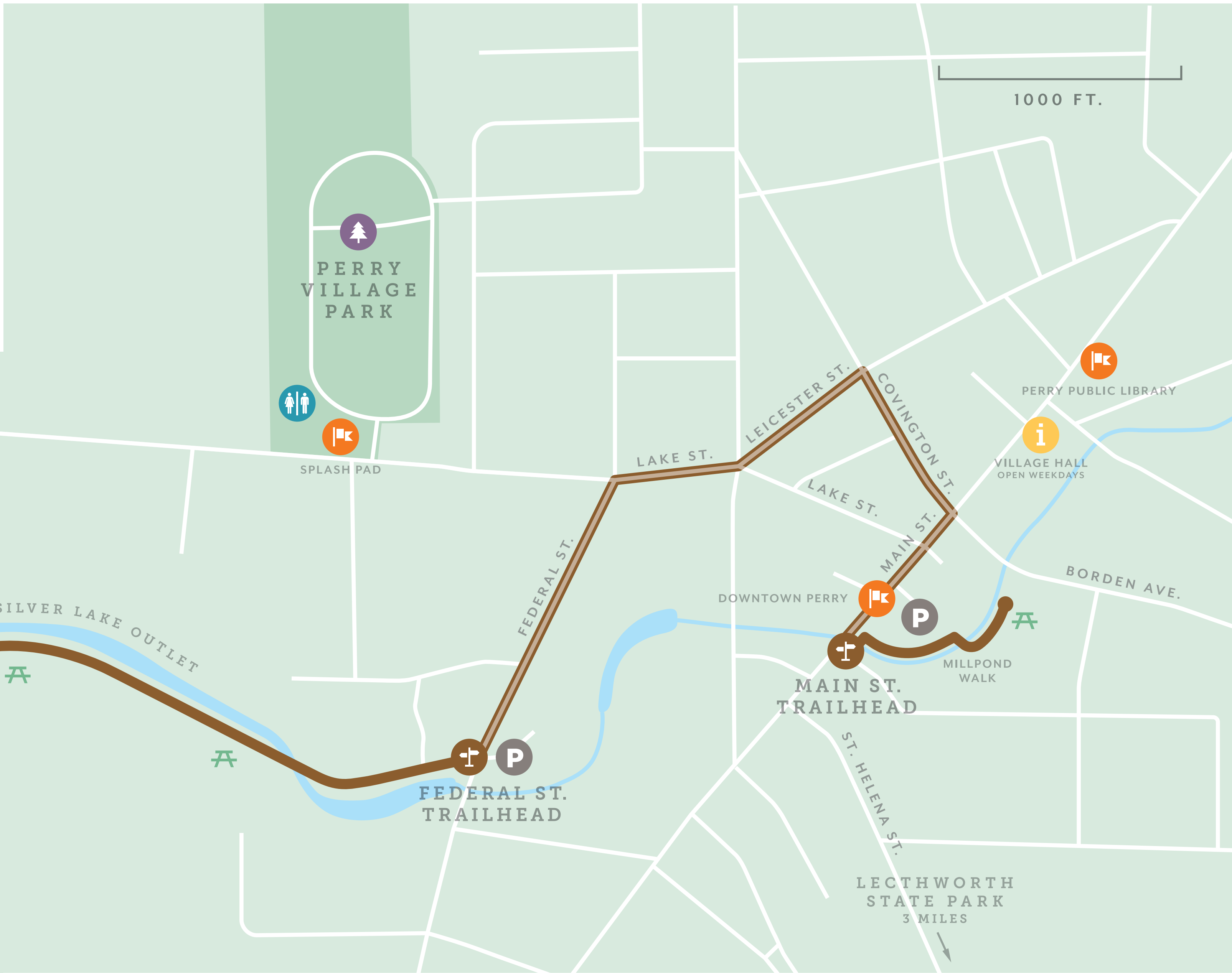
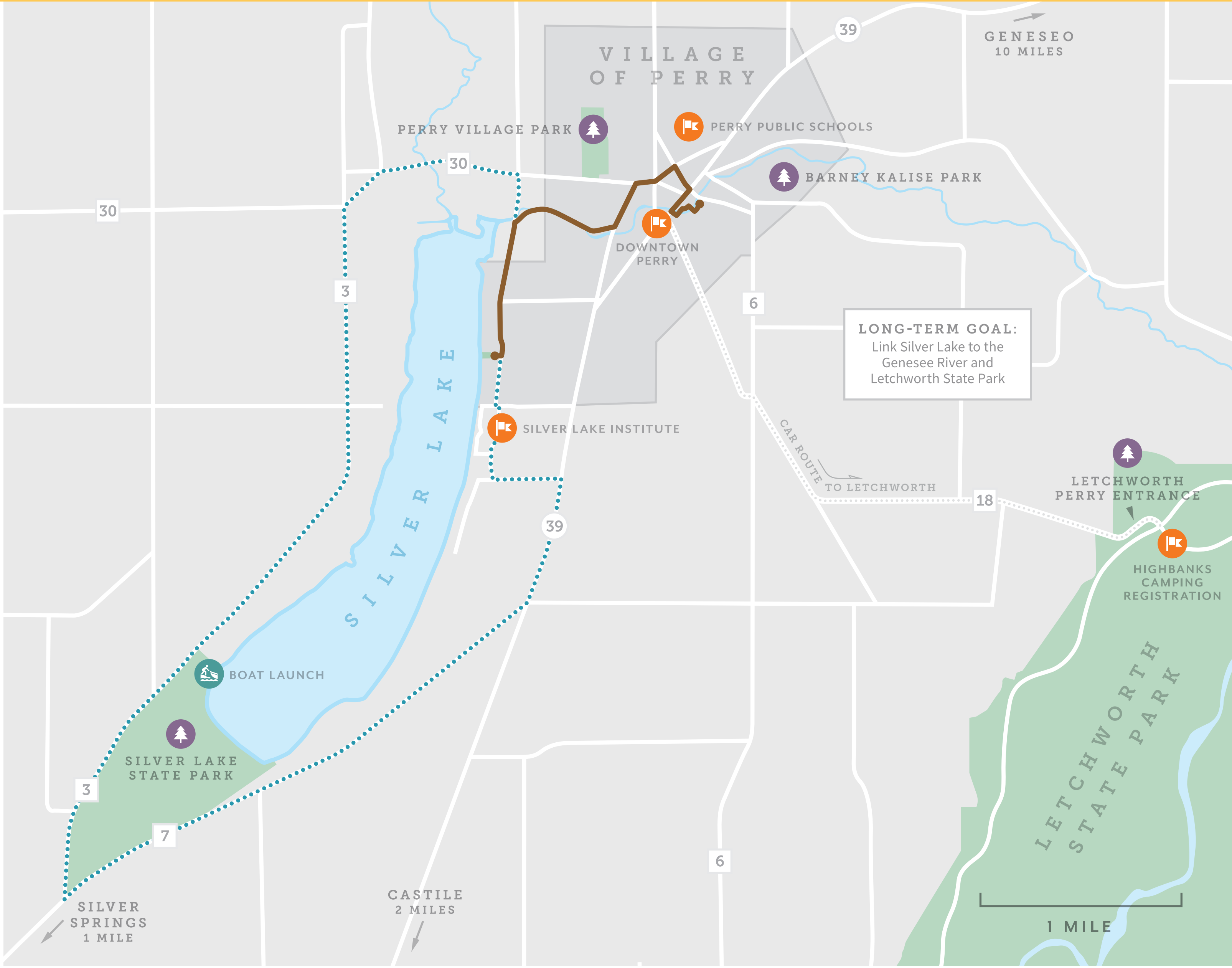

TRAIL OVERVIEW

The Silver Lake Trail is a multi-use trail with segments that are on and off street. Its current route travels from Downtown Perry to Perry Public Beach Park on Silver Lake. Part of the route travels on a former railway bed along Silver Lake Outlet. This trail offers opportunities to explore the Village of Perry, Silver Lake and the surrounding areas.

Please note that the trail segment from Perry Public Beach to the Silver Lake Rd. Trailhead is on street only. Please use caution.
